The American Brahman Breeders Association is calling for applications from young people aged between 18-25 years old interested in applying for the Australian Student Exchange Scholarship.

The successful applicant will receive round trip airfare from Houston, Texas to Rockhampton, Q, Australia.

The successful applicant will gain experience in the activities conducted on the Brahman ranches of the host family and live in the normal family environment.

Please note applications close on the 15th of April. Guidelines for the scholarship are as follows:

1. Applicants must be 18-25 years of age.
2. Applicants must be able to demonstrate a connection with the American Brahman Breeders Association.
3. Applicants must be free to travel during the year the scholarship is awarded.
4. Applicants are asked to (1) complete the reply form below: (2) state briefly on a separate sheet the reasons for wanting to win the scholarship together with a resume of their qualifications and experience and (3) provide written references.
5. Final selection of the successful applicant will be made by a committee appointed by the Youth Activity committee following personal interviews.
6. The scholarship will be restricted to a round trip airfare from Houston, TX, USA to Rockhampton, Q, Australia.
7. The ABBA shall make arrangements through the Australian Brahman Association for placement with families in Australia who are members of the ABBA, who will provide laundry and meals. Applicants may need to provide some funds.
8. The scholarship shall be for 30 to 60 day duration.
9. Extension of time in Australia shall not be permitted without approval from the ABBA.
10. Applications close on April 15.

1. To travel to Australia (the host country) and to remain there as a participant in the Australian Student Exchange for a period of 30-60 days, living in homes approved by the Australian Brahman Breeders Association (the host association);
2. To comply at all times with the rules of the said scholarship exchange program and with a directive from time to time given by the ABBA or any member, officer, director and/or committee member in relation thereto;
3. To be responsible for providing all necessary clothing for my comfort and welfare;
4. To provide all funds to meet charges not covered by the scholarship money and/or allowance offered by the host association members;
5. To save and hold harmless all host parents and members of their families and all members, officers, directors and committee members of both the ABBA and the host association from any and all liability which I may or could claim or assert against any such family, association or any of their members, officers, directors and committee members by reason of any injury which could be suffered by me or by reason of my death, and for loss of or damage to any money or personal property during the period of my stay in Australia expressly waiving any and all claims for liability which I could assert for any reason or on any grounds whatsoever
6. That I will return immediately to my home at the completion of 30 to 60 days or earlier should, in the opinion of the host association or the ABBA, my repatriation be considered desirable for any of the following reasons:
 - a. Due to a breach by me of the scholarship rules;
 - b. Due to a breach by me of the laws of either Australia or the United States of America;
 - c. Due to my incompatibility;
 - d. Due to my misbehavior; or
 - e. Any other cause.
7. To effect a minimum \$25,000.00 One-Year Accidental Death Insurance Policy on my life. Insurance shall be effective for the duration of my participation in this program.

All questions concerning the subject matter hereof and any and all claims shall be governed by the applicable laws of the State of Texas, United States of America.

I GIVE PERMISSION for all emergency surgery, administration of anesthetic or blood transfusion for urgent treatment of any illness or injury which a qualified medical practitioner may deem necessary for my welfare. I specifically assign to the elected President from time to time of the host association, the legal right to sign all medical emergency release documents both for Doctors and for Hospitals on my behalf.
