Major Responsibilities:

- Assist the Director of Communications and Youth Activities with the planning and management of the 2022 AJBA All American National Junior Brahman Show
- Assist in collecting and processing entries for the AJBA All American.
- Coordinate with the Junior Board of Directors in assisting in execution of leadership contests and end of year awards banquet.
- Assist in management of social media outlets before, during and after the AJBA All American.
- This is a very travel heavy internship and work hours fluctuate as workload changes. Working on the weekends is also a possibility and other times as assigned.

Compensation:
